Teacher/Coach position

Part-time

This teacher-coach position will include 2-hour classes from (2:30 to 5:30) at one or more different elementary or middle schools in East Austin (AISD). Classes will be held once (min.) each week at each of the schools (with the exception of AISD holiday) during the spring semester. The lacrosse activity is part of academic support for an at-risk student population. Some academic emphasis or alignment may he required, such as reiteration or support of current studies that tie somehow to the lacrosse activities. Examples might be exposure to history of lacrosse or cultural studies (use of lacrosse in Native American culture). The lacrosse activity will center on established STXBall teaching curriculum (upon request) and STXBall game (upon request). The classes may be co-educational and will be non-contact. There will be some sort coordination with team curriculum created by another teacher-coach.

The New Horizons Lacrosse Fund will provide soft-stick lacrosse equipment. NHLF Services will provide proposed curriculum and work with the teacher/coach on individual lesson plans and will supervise and monitor activities.

The teacher/coach will be a subcontractor to NHLF Services and will be responsible for withholding taxes and for providing TxDPS background check documentation. A valid W-9 will be required by successful applicants.

The teacher/coach agrees to arrange, with the prior consent of NHLF, for any teacher/coach substitutions 48 hours in advance of any class.

NHLF Services will reimburse teacher/coach travel within Austin at the rate of .50/mile. NHLF Services will pay coaches \$20/hour for in-class time hours.

Qualifications under consideration include:

- Playing, coaching, teaching experience
- Other work experience
- Academic success
- Leadership skills
- Spanish language as an asset

Background check (finger-printing) is required.

Applicants should be enrolled or a graduate of college/university.
