

THSLL/TSLA MEETING MINUTES

December 9, 2025

THSLL Board Meeting was called to order by Troy at 7:06 pm.

Michael Brand was introduced and shared his background in lacrosse coaching and administration. The board welcomed his involvement as the Class C San Antonio coordinator.

Vista Ridge, Rouse, Liberty Hill

The board discussed multiple requests from parents of freshmen who would like to play outside their zoned programs. The board reaffirmed that hardship waivers must be submitted by the receiving program and approved by the league. Preference-based transfers are not permitted.

Troy will notify programs to submit hardship requests where applicable. Sean suggested additional board members communicate with the programs.

Klein

Klein HS is unable to field a team. Sean met with the team presidents and coaches to discuss the four players who are currently registered with Klein. They will be given the option to play for either Cy-Fair or Magnolia due to their status as displaced players. Any other Klein players who were not registered at the time of the meeting, will make a one time decision to play for either Cy-Fair or Magnolia. If Klein reforms a team the players may choose to play for Klein.

Sean motioned to allow the Klein players to play for Cy-Fair or Magnolia without waivers. Dave seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Goal Net Logos

A team contacted a coordinator about placing a logo on their team net. THSLL will follow NCAA rules regarding logo placement on goal nets. Large or obstructive logos are not permitted.

The NCAA rules are:

Goal Nets • Provided that the mesh of the net does not exceed 1½ inches it may be of varying shapes (square, hexagon, octagon, etc.). In addition, advertising on goal nets has become a challenge for officials to see if the ball has crossed the goal line or entered the goal. Only institutional, commercial and memorial logos are permitted to be affixed to the back center of the goal nets no higher than three feet.

Fort Worth Lacrosse

Fort Worth Lacrosse fielded a Class D Varsity program in 2024 and did not field a team in 2025. Fort Worth Lacrosse applied to field a Class D JV team for the 2026 season. R.L. Paschal is the host school and Fort Worth Youth Lacrosse is the youth feeder program. Will motioned to accept Fort Worth Lacrosse as a Class D JV program. Dave seconded the motion. The motion carried.
